The Other Developed Property will be individually assigned a certain number of RLEs based on property size, impervious surface, and calculated storm water run-off. The property will also receive a credit if it has a storm water retention pond or facility on-site.

WATER AVAILABILITY CHARGE (WAC) UNITS & SEWER AVAILABILITY CHARGE (SAC) UNITS

The City will adopt and use the Met-Council WAC & SAC schedule to determine the units for calculation of fees, excluding residential multifamily. Residential multifamily per unit (duplex, fourplex, apartments, etc.) 2 units=1 WAC/SAC.
