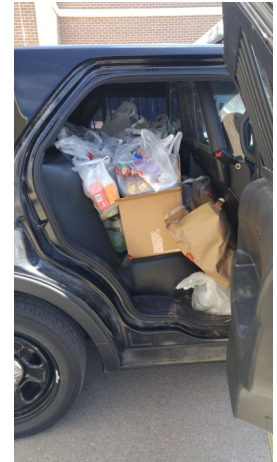

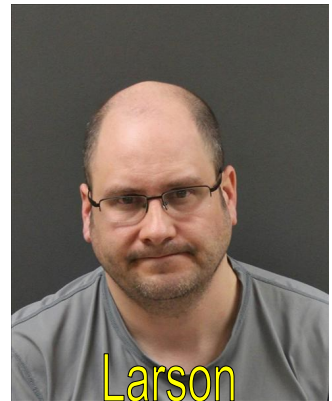

Sexual Assault, Threats

On Saturday, March 18th, **Officers Josh Alexander, Mal-lory House, Said Hilowle, Sergeant Mark Krenik and RCSO Deputy Jason Witt** responded to a residence for a reported disturbance. The caller told officers he was awakened by a female at his door who asked him to call 911. The woman told officers she had been at a neighboring residence when a man began touching her. She told him to stop, and eventually locked herself in a bathroom for about an hour. She told officers the suspect was holding a rifle and threatened to shoot her when

she fled the residence. As she was talking to officers, the suspect drove past and was stopped by Deputy Witt, who could see a rifle in the truck. During an interview, the victim asked to go to the hospital for a sexual assault exam, and reported she had been sexually assaulted. The suspect, Jason Larson, 37 was arrested and jailed without incident. **Detectives Scott Duncan, Matt Kolling, Jeff Burbank and Sergeant Dave Dillon** responded to further investigate. Larson was charged with 1st degree Criminal Sexual Conduct, 3rd degree Criminal Sex-

ual Conduct, 2nd degree Assault and Terroristic Threats. His bail was set at \$60,000 with conditions.



Domestic Assault Arrest

Officer Chris Tonjum responded to an assault report on Wednesday, March 22nd. The victim reported arguing with his girlfriend, who was intoxicated at the time. During the argument, the suspect threatened the victim with a knife. He stated she also broke a door and struck him with a coffee cup. Ofc. Tonjum could see injuries consistent with his report. The suspect, Kelly Ki-



zer, 51, was arrested and jailed. She was charged with 2nd degree Assault and Domestic Assault (felony). Her bail was set at \$50,000 with conditions.
