Assault Arrest

On Sunday, June 4th, **Officers Mallory House, Matt Shuda, Said Hilowle and Sergeant Eric Sammon** responded to a reported stabbing. The female caller told the dispatcher she was locked in a bathroom with her two minor children for her safety. She reported that a male in the residence was intoxicated, and cut her neck while they were arguing. **RCSO Deputies Daryl Mador, Steve Bauer, Jason Witt, Sergeant Jeff Mullenmeister,** Minnesota State Patrol **Trooper Patric**

Ignaszewski and Lieutenant Nancy O’Connell arrived to assist. After being let into the building by another resident, the officers were able to evacuate the victim and children to safety. Officers were able to talk the suspect, James Gordon, 53, into surrendering and he was arrested without further incident. After being taken to a detox facility he was jailed and charged with 2nd degree Assault (two counts), Terroristic Threats and Domestic Assault (two counts). His bail was set at \$7,500 with

conditions.

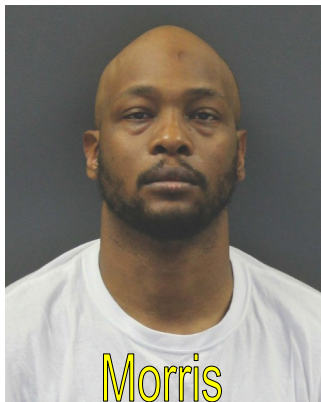

Undercover Arrests

On Tuesday, June 6th, as the culmination of a methamphetamine trafficking investigation, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** arrested Melvin Morris, 36, and Ashley Smith, 22. Morris had been in contact with an undercover officer and agreed to travel to Faribault from St. Paul to sell methamphetamine. On Tuesday, the undercover officer met with Morris and Smith. After giving Morris the money, Smith gave the officer a baggie later determined to be 29 grams of methamphetamine. After walking away from the area, assisting officers and deputies stopped and arrested Morris and Smith without incident. Morris, of St.

Paul, was charged with 1st degree Drugs - Sales and his bail was set at \$7,500 with conditions. Smith, of West St. Paul, was charged with 1st degree Drugs - Sales and released on her own recogni-

zance by the court. The agents were assisted by **Detectives Matt Kolling, DJ Skluzacek, Sergeant Brandon Gliem, Officers Lisa Petricka, Sarah Tollefson** and RSCO **Deputy Steve Bauer.**
