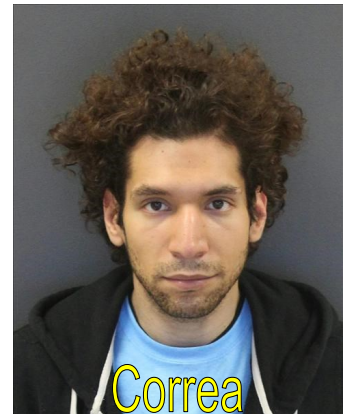

## Burglar Busted

On Thursday, June 22nd, **Officer Tony Larson** responded to a reported burglary at the Faribault Area Senior Center. On his arrival, he noted a male hanging around the library area while it was closed. He stopped to identify the male, who told him that he was homeless and had been dropped off in Faribault to buy drugs. Ofc. Larson then met with Senior Center staff, who had discovered used silverware and a partially consumed pop can. They also reported cash and checks missing. **Detective Jeff Burbank** and **Sergeant Brandon Gliem** arrived to assist. They were

informed by a staff member at the Community Center of a male who was discovered trying to hide in their building the night before. The officers reviewed video surveillance footage, and Ofc. Larson noted the image was the same male he had spoken to earlier. The following day, Det. Burbank was notified that Owatonna PD had detained the suspect, Mario Correa, 23. Assisted by **Detective DJ Skluzacek**, Det. Burbank interviewed Correa, who admitted to the burglary and stated he had just been looking for something to eat. He was arrested and jailed. Correa was charged



with 3rd degree Burglary and he was released on his own recognizance by the court.

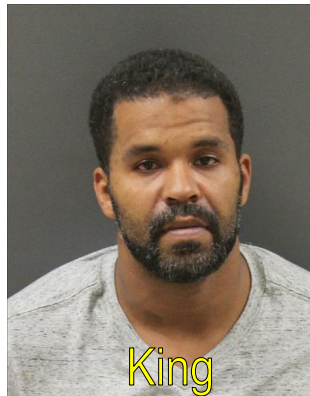

## DWI Arrest

On Saturday, June 24th, **Sergeant Matt Long** observed a vehicle traveling in excess of the speed limit on Central Avenue. He conducted a traffic stop and met with the driver while **Officer Ben Johns** arrived to assist. The driver refused to speak with officers. Sgt. Long could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver, and noted he appeared intoxicated. The driver refused to complete any field sobriety tests and was



arrested. He was identified as Marcus King, 34. At the jail, King refused to submit to any alcohol testing. He was jailed and charged with DWI - Refuse to Test and released on his own recognizance by the court.

## OFP Arrest

On Tuesday, June 27th, **Officer Matt Shuda** responded to a reported burglary. The victim stated she heard someone enter her residence through a blocked door and discovered her husband, against whom she has an Order for Protection (OFP), standing in the home. The suspect began yelling at the victim and took her purse and phone, preventing her from calling for help. The victim fled upstairs and

called police from her child's phone while the suspect fled. A short time later, Ofc. Shuda was notified by Albert Lea police that they had located the suspect, Joshua Prestegard, 36, at his parents' residence and arrested him. Prestegard was jailed and charged with Stalking, 1st degree Burglary, Interfering with an Emergency Call and Violation of an OFP. His bail was set at \$30,000 with conditions.
