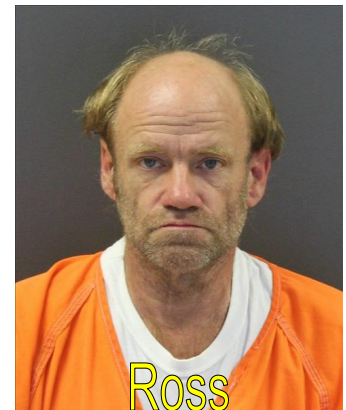

## Trespass Arrest

On Sunday, October 8th, **Officers Mallory House and Chris Tonjum** responded to an apartment complex for a trespassing complaint. The caller stated they had seen a person in the complex’s garages area and knew the person had been previously trespassed from the property. On her arrival, Ofc. House noticed the suspect, Mark Ross, 56. When Ross saw her, he fled from the area on a bike. Ofc. House saw him again a short distance away and stopped him. Ross denied

being in the area. While checking Ross for weapons, Ofc. House found loose ammunition in his pockets, as well as a syringe and a multi-tool with a knife blade. Ross also had a copy of his trespass notice barring him from the apartment property. Ross was arrested and jailed. He was charged with Possession of Ammunition (Ross has a previous crime of violence conviction), Possession of a Hypodermic Needle, and Trespassing. His bail was set at \$1,000 with conditions.



## Warrant Watch

This week we're looking for Faisal Abdullahi, 27. He is the subject of two warrants for failing to appear. His original charges include Fleeing a Peace Officer, Drugs - Simulated, and Theft. Abdullahi is 5'11", weighs 145 pounds, has black hair and brown eyes.

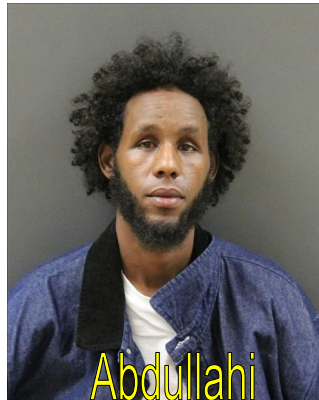
We are also seeking the whereabouts of Randy Guajardo, 20. He is the subject of four arrest warrants on original charges of 1st degree Burglary, 3rd degree Criminal Damage to Property, 3rd degree Assault, 5th degree Assault, Terroristic Threats, and false Calls to 911. Guajardo is 5'08", weighs 180 pounds, has black hair and brown eyes.

Finally, we are looking for Scott Pew, 53. He is the subject of two warrants - one for probation violation and one for failing to appear. He is also the subject of a Kanabec County warrant. Pew is 5'9", weighs 190 pounds, has brown hair and blue eyes.

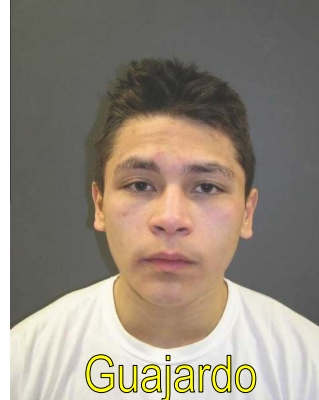

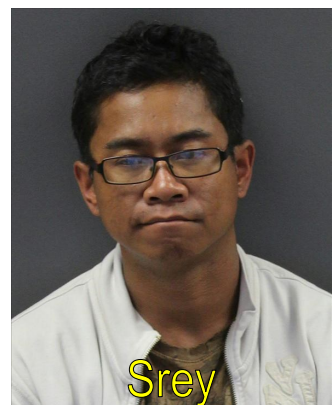

## Drugs & Warrant Arrest

On Monday, October 9th, **Detective Jeff Burbank** spotted a vehicle he knew from previous contacts. He also knew the driver, Nam Srey, 36, was the subject of a Scott County arrest warrant and that his driving privileges were suspended. Det. Burbank saw Srey park in a remote area of a business parking lot, and then enter a second vehicle which arrived after him. As **Officer Tony Larson** and **Sergeant Eric Sammon** arrived to assist, Det. Burbank approached the

second vehicle and informed Srey he was under arrest. As Srey was exiting the vehicle, Det. Burbank saw him drop something inside the vehicle and saw that it was a lighter and baggie of suspected methamphetamine. The baggie tested positive for meth. Srey was also found to have a digital scale with methamphetamine residue. Srey was charged with 3rd degree Controlled Substances - Sales, 5th degree Controlled Substances, and Driving After Suspension. His

bail was set at \$40,000 with conditions.
