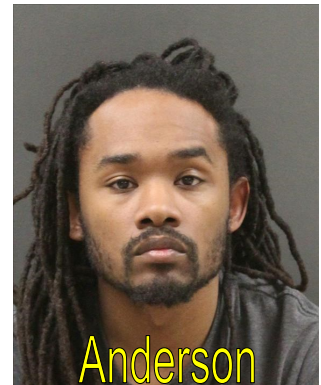

Wheels 4 Sale

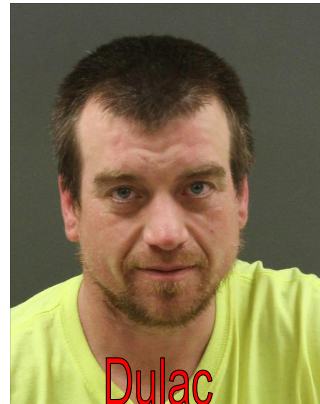
On Monday, April 2nd, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** were asked to assist the **South Central Drug Investigation Unit** and **Albert Lea PD** detectives. Albert Lea PD was investigating the theft of tires and wheels from several new trucks which had occurred over the past weekend, and located a subject attempting to sell the same wheels on

Craigslist. Agents arranged to meet the seller in Faribault, and an undercover agent bought four wheels, valued at \$1200 each. The agents were able to scan and verify the wheels had been stolen in Albert Lea. The suspect was stopped on I-35 and arrested. He was charged with Receiving Stolen Property and Driving After Revocation. His bail was set at \$5,000 with conditions.



Court Order Violation

On Tuesday, April 3rd, **Officer Sarah Tollefson** was dispatched to a reported restraining order violation. The caller stated a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO) was in place, one condition of which barred the respondent from being within 1/2 mile of her workplace. She reported she had just seen the suspect at her workplace and he was leaving the area on a bicycle. While en route, Ofc. Tollefson spotted



the suspect on foot and stopped him. He admitted he had been in the area, and did not think the victim worked there any longer but could not provide a reason for being in the area. After confirming the victim's report, the suspect, Alex Dulac, 39, was arrested and jailed. He was charged with Stalking, Harassment Restraining Order Violation, and DANCO violation. His bail was set at \$100,000 without conditions.

Sexual Assault Awareness Month

April is Sexual Assault Awareness Month. Statistics indicate one in five women and one in 71 men will be sexually assaulted at some point in their lives. Additionally, one in four girls and one in six boys will be sexually abused before the age of 18. In 2017, we responded to 38 reports of sexual assault. The most underreported crime, an estimated 5% to 20% of assaults are reported to police.
