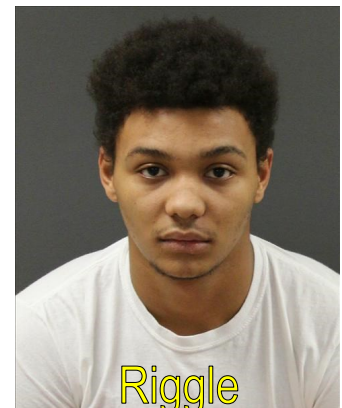

Drug Arrest

On Friday, October 26th, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** observed a person whom they had probable cause to arrest for a previous drug sale. Agents approached the suspect, Taewan Riggle, 18, and placed him under arrest. As officers approached him, he attempted to hand off a bag to another person. Agents seized the bag, and discovered a large bag of suspected marijuana

inside, as well as a digital scale. The bag later weighed in at 47.95 grams. Riggle was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substance - Sale and 5th degree Controlled Substance - Possession. Riggle was also charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances - Sales for the earlier drug sale. Riggle was released on his own recognizance by the court.



Domestic Assault Arrest

On Sunday, October 28th, **Officers Chris Tonjum, Cadie Spicer and Sergeant Mark Krenik** responded to a reported assault. At the scene, Ofc. Tonjum spoke with a female who reported her boyfriend had punched and strangled her. A witness at the residence also stated she saw the suspect, Henry Fox, 34, assault the victim. Ofc. Tonjum could see cuts and bruises on the victim's face and neck. She was transported to Allina-District One Hospital for treat-



ment of her injuries. An alert was issued to surrounding agencies to locate Fox, and a short time later Ofc. Tonjum learned that Fox had been stopped and arrested by Owatonna police for DWI. After his release from Steele County, Fox was transported to the Rice County jail. He was charged with Domestic Assault by Strangulation and Domestic Assault (two counts). His bail was set at \$5,000 with conditions.

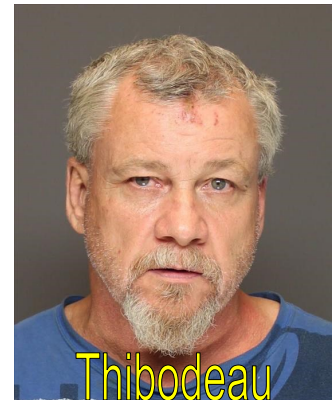

On Tuesday, October 30th, **Officer Sean Smallen** observed a vehicle which appeared to be travelling over the posted speed limit. He confirmed the vehicle was speeding by radar. Ofc. Smallen stopped the vehicle and met with the driver, Earl Thibodeau, 52. Thibodeau admitted that his driving privileges were cancelled, and Ofc. Smallen confirmed his license status was indeed "Cancelled - Inimical to Public Safety". Thibodeau was placed under arrest. On the

way to the jail, Thibodeau began to bang his head against the partition in the squad. He told Ofc. Smallen he was attempting to "break his neck". At the jail, Thibodeau was uncooperative with jail staff, and smeared excrement on the holding cell windows and camera. Thibodeau was cited for Driving After Cancellation, Speeding and Disorderly Conduct. He was released on his own recognizance by the court.
