Chief Bohlen testified that the several Violent Offender Task Forces across the state are making a dent in criminal activity, and forfeitures are a valid tool for the task forces. Chief Bohlen advocated for the legislators to be cautious on how the forfeiture law is modified as it has a direct impact on criminal activity.

## Pursuit Nabs Two

On Monday, March 25th, **Officer Tony Larson** attempted to stop a vehicle which was speeding. Rather than stopping, the driver sped up and ran a stop sign and stop light in an effort to elude the officer. The suspect continued fleeing on I-35 as assisting officers joined the pursuit. As the vehicle en-



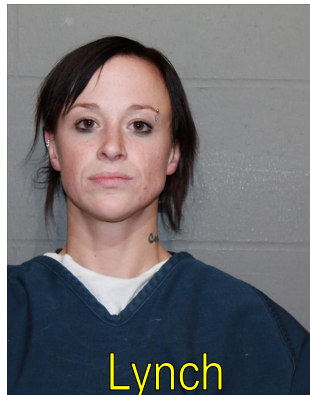
tered Dundas, a tire deflation device disabled the vehicle, which continued driving through Dundas before stopping at the edge of Northfield. The driver, Nicholas Anderson, 35, ran from the vehicle and was apprehended by **RCSO Deputy Colbey Hullett** and **Officer Sean Smallen**. Anderson was found to be the subject of a department of Corrections arrest warrant. The passenger remained in the vehicle and ignored the officers' repeated commands. The South Metro SWAT Team responded to assist and eventually deployed tear gas into the vehicle, causing the passenger, Matthew Jones, 26, to exit. Both suspects were jailed. Anderson was charged with Fleeing a

Peace Officer, Fleeing on Foot, Driving After Revocation and Reckless Driving, and his bail was set at \$50,000 with no conditions. Jones was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances and Obstructing Legal Process. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.

## DANCO Arrest

On Sunday, March 24th, **Sergeant Matt Knutson** responded to a report of a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO). The caller reported that she had seen the suspect, Stephen Clendenin, 34, at the victim's residence. She knew that he was barred from the residence and knew that the victim was out of town. Clendenin was not at the resi-

dence when Sgt. Knutson checked, but notified officers to watch for him. On March 27th, **Officer Josh Sjodin** received another call that Clendenin was back at the residence. Officers responded and found Clendenin. He was arrested and cited for Violation of a DANCO for both dates. His bail was set at \$5,000 with conditions.
