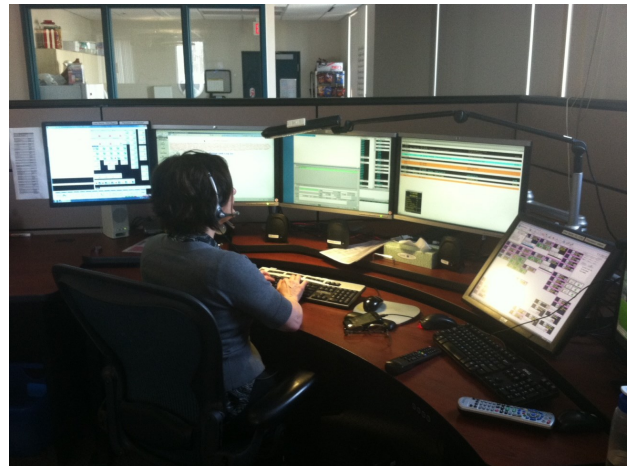

On Tuesday, April 16th, Chief **Andy Bohlen** presented Life-saving awards to **Officers Sarah Tollefson, Scott Duncan** and **Matt Shuda**. On March 5th, the trio responded to a medical call and found a man without a detectable pulse. They performed CPR and delivered shocks with an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) until the man began breathing on his own. The man was flown to a metro-area hospital for further treatment and later released.

During this month and throughout the year, the men and women of the Faribault Police Department are dedicated to supporting families to reduce the risk of child abuse and neglect. Our detectives work with Rice County child protection workers on a daily basis, teaming up
