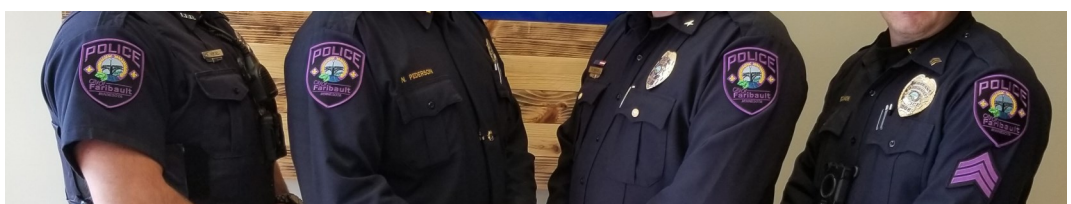
Burbank, Captains Jason Severson, Dave Dillon and Neal Pederson all assisted with traffic control.

Domestic Assault Arrest

On October 14th, **Officers Michael Shuda, Ben Borash, Tony Larson and Sergeant Mark Krenik** responded to a reported disturbance. On their arrival, Ofc. Shuda spoke with a female resident who reported she had been assaulted by her husband. She stated he had strangled her, making it difficult to breathe. The suspect, Alonso Olivo, 28, denied striking or strangling the victim. Olivo was

arrested and jailed. He was charged with Domestic Assault and Domestic Assault by Strangulation, and he was released on his own recognizance by the court.
