



ANNUAL WATER RESTRICTIONS KNOW YOUR WATERING SCHEDULE



To conserve water resources and allow the city's water system flexibility in meeting peak demands, certain limitations must be placed on the city's water supply. ***An odd-even sprinkling restriction based on street addresses is in effect annually from May 1 to September 30 each year.*** City water cannot be used for the purposes of irrigating or watering lawn, sod, or seeded areas between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily.

The hours between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. are the hottest part of the day and over 30% of the water used can be lost to evaporation.

Monday is a 'No Watering' day. City water cannot be used for the purposes of irrigating or watering lawns, sod, or seeded areas.

Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays (before 10 a.m. and after 5 p.m.)

- Even-numbered residences (addresses ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, 8) are permitted to water.
- Commercial customers are permitted to water.

Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday (before 10 a.m. and after 5 p.m.)

- Odd-numbered residences (addresses ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, 9) are permitted to water.
- Homeowners Associations and apartment complexes that provide a common irrigation system are permitted to water.

New Lawn Registration

Call the Public Works Department at (507) 333-0361 for a 30 day exemption for new sod or seed. Some restrictions remain in effect, including no water on Monday and no watering between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily.

City water cannot be used for the purposes of irrigating or watering lawn, sod, or seeded areas between 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. daily.
